F.O.G. FATS, OIL's, AND GREASE

Blockages are serious and lead to plumbing backups inside homes.

EXAMPLES INCLUDE:

- Cooking Oils
- Butter, margarine, and shortening
- Salad dressing
- Gravy
- Bacon and sausage grease
- Mayonnaise
- Peanut butter
- Dairy products



F.O.G Pollution occurs when these products are poured down sinks, garbage disposals, or storm drains.

The substances solidify and accumulate around the insides of drainpipes. This can lead to blockages, backups, pipe bursts and overflows.



NEVER POUR GREASE DOWN A SINK DRAIN, GARBAGE DISPOSAL, TOILET, OR STORM DRAIN!

1. ALLOW THE GREASE TO COOL.
2. SCRAPE INTO A DISPOSABLE CONTAINER.
3. WIPE PAN CLEAN WITH PAPER TOWEL.
4. PLACE INTO THE GARBAGE FOR DISPOSAL.

HOW TO DISPOSE OF COOKING OIL

1. Let it cool



2. Put it in a disposable container



3. Throw it in the trash
